The pieces must be at least a Level IV according to the CAPMT Student Evaluations grading guidelines.

Maximum Performance Time Limits:

Category III	16yrs-18yrs	10 minutes
Category IV	19yrs-23yrs	15 minutes

All pieces must be performed by memory.

Applicants must provide scores for the judges - NO XEROX copies!
